### **Tampa-based National Center for Cyber Studies and Saint Leo University Waive Cyber Program Admission Application Fees for Veterans**

*Now greater Tampa Bay area veterans can apply at no cost for admission to the CYBER FOUNDATIONS pilot program.*

The National Center for Cyber Studies and Saint Leo University announce a waiver of application fees for all verified veterans who apply to the online Cyber Foundations pilot program scheduled to begin March 2, 2015. The registration deadline is Feb 18, 2015.

“Waiving admission application fees is a continuation of the commitment we share with Saint Leo University to train veterans for high skill, high paying cyber jobs,” says Michael F. Shapiro, Executive Director of the National Cyber Partnership, the parent organization of the National Center for Cyber Studies.

Shapiro adds, “We can waive the fees thanks to the cooperation of Saint Leo and the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, whose funding launched the CYBER FOUNDATIONS program. State funding has already allowed us to offer full-tuition scholarships to eligible veterans for the courses developed by National Center for Cyber Studies for the program. Veterans can use their benefits towards the costs of the Saint Leo courses.”

**CYBER FOUNDATIONS** is a new model for cybersecurity education created by the not-for-profit, 501(c)(3) public-private National Cyber Partnership and is sponsored by the National Cyber Partnership and the State of Florida, Department of Economic Opportunity.
